Beginner Implant Training and Education

- Implant dentistry is the least covered topic in dental school and is often overlooked as a treatment option by young dentists, but in reality it is now considered relatively routine dentistry in the mainstream and an option which cannot be overlooked.
- The course places a strong emphasis on skills supported by interactive learning by case discussion and lectures.
- The aim of the starter day course is to equip young dentists with the knowledge and tools to understand the role implant dentistry plays in general practice today.
- The course will cover topics such as: case assessment, appropriate referral and management of complications. The course will have a strong focus on “how to ” get involved in implant dentistry in both surgical and restorative components.
- The day will finish with a number of hands-on components, including impressions of, and restoring, dental implants.
